

# Directed Blood Donation

Parental/Guardian consent for 16 year-olds



By California law, all 16-year-olds must have a parent's or legal guardian's permission to give a directed donation. Donated blood is used by Stanford for any use it deems advisable and any rights or ownership with respect to the donated blood is relinquished by the donor.

**Please note, if consent is not properly completed and signed, with an indelible blue or black ballpoint pen only, minor will not be allowed to donate. Different colored inks, pencil, felt-tipped pens and white out are not permitted. The current version of the form is 13.0. No other version will be accepted.**
